Program Highlights

Ideal Candidates

- Are committed to deepening their professional leadership capacity alongside a cohort of fellow women leaders
- Have been in roles managing staff, projects, and/or budgets
- Are looking to expand their professional and personal community
- Live, work, and/or serve communities in the Greater Los Angeles area

Program Components

- 60 hours of immersive training, offered in the Fall & Spring for five, 2-day paired sessions
- Leadership Forums provide professional development sessions focusing on navigating challenges through a gender identity lens.
- Coro Conversations are cohort-led discussions focusing on workplace challenges for women to enhance real-time professional development.
- Peer Consultancies offer adaptive leadership peer coaching to diagnose challenges and test solutions in an empowered environment.
